PROVINCIAL LAW NO. 16 AND INNOVATION PLAN

The Open Data Trentino project fulfils the regulation (provincial law no. 16/2012) regarding the open source software and open data, and the Innovation Plan for the PAT, which identifies open data as an instrument for growth and development.



The "Open Data in Trentino" project aims at developing an infrastructure that supports the innovation and the economic growth of Trentino. It is based on a collaboration between the Autonomous Province of Trento (PAT), Trento RISE, Informatica Trentina, the Bruno Kessler Foundation, and the University of Trento.

GUIDELINES

The provincial council approves "The guidelines for the distribution and the reuse of public data", an indispensable instrument for whoever in Trentino is interested in opening and adding value to their data.

PROJECT TEAM OF TRENTINO OPEN DATA

The team starts working on the data collection and publication, as well as on legal, semantic and organizational aspects, and on the engagement with the local, national and international communities.

The experimental version of the catalogue is online and contains 300 datasets from the Province and other public institutions! It is based on CKAN 1.8, an open source platform used throughout the world, such as in the EU, USA, UK as well as many Italian administrative offices.

ENGAGEMENT OF THE ADMINISTRATION

Each department of the Province nominates an open data domain expert and provides at least one dataset to be published by the end of 2013.

JUNE

600 DATASETS

The catalogue is now integrated with the provincial information system, and also updated to CKAN 2.2. It now holds more than 600 datasets from 35 different providers!

BEST PRACTICE: CADASTRAL OPEN DATA

For the first time in Italy the cadastral parcels are released as open data. This achievement will lead the Province to receive the "OpenGeoData 2013" award.
